# **PFAS UPDATE**



In Spring of 2025, the Illinois EPA amended the statewide drinking water regulations related to PFAS. A summary of the key changes are depicted below.

#### WHAT TO KNOW ABOUT RIGHT-TO-KNOW

Illinois' Title 35 Part 620 Regulations provide standards for managing groundwater (GW) resources across the state. On April 11, 2025, the Illinois Pollution Control Board (IPCB) adopted amendments to Part 620, which include GW standards for PFOA, PFOS, PFHXS, PFNA, HFPO-DA, and PFBS. These levels generally match the current federal MCLs of either 4 ng/L or 10 ng/L. Under the IEPA's "Right-to-Know" requirements, community water systems (CWSs) drawing GW containing PFAS (or other constituents) at or above Part 620 standards must issue a one-time notification to all customers within five business days of receiving notice from the IEPA that their system(s) do not meet state-established standards. The IEPA has already identified and contacted the known 47 CWSs in Illinois with PFAS in their GW on April 14, 2025. If future GW sample results in additional CWSs registering above the standards, Part 620 Right-to-Know action is expected to be required by the IEPA. The graphic below illustrates these Right-to-Know actions.












#### REMINDERS ABOUT REPORTING AND SAMPLING

- IEPA will accept PFAS samples taken after 1/1/2019 towards initial sampling requirements for PFAS, including UCMR 5 samples
- Communities who have taken UCMR 5 samples and have PFAS detections at or above the UCMR 5 MRL must include in their CCRs:
  - A list of detected species of PFAS
  - · Reporting level average
  - Range of detections in CCRs
- All CWS serving 10,000 or more customers must issue two (<sup>II</sup>) CCRs per year beginning in April 2027. Most recent PFAS sample results must be included in each report. See the timeline displayed below.


# **PFAS UPDATE**



In Spring and Summer of 2025, the USEPA provided updates to the national drinking water regulations related to PFAS. A summary of the key changes are depicted below.

### THE NATIONAL PRIMARY DRINKING WATER REGULATION

On May 14, 2025, the USEPA issued a press release sharing proposed updates to the PFAS NPDWR published in April 2024. The USEPA expects to release a draft of the updated/revised Rule in the Fall of 2025 and a finalized version in the Spring of 2026.





## **USEPA's BEST PFAS SAMPLING PRACTICES**
